Make Music is a free world wide celebration of music always held on June 21st, Summer Solstice. Launched in 1982 as the Fête de la Musique in France, it is now held on the same day in more than 700 cities in 103 countries. Participating North American cities include Austin, Boston, New York City, Madison, Los Angeles, Vancouver, BC, Philadelphia, Nashville and Madison, WI. Completely different from a typical music festival, Make Music is open to anyone who wants to take part. Every kind of musician — young and old, amateur and professional, of every musical persuasion — pours onto streets, parks, plazas, and porches to share their music with friends, neighbors, and strangers.

In Seattle, all Make Music Day events are:

- Free & participatory for everyone
- All ages and genre
- At multiple venues and public spaces All live performances
- Simultaneously scheduled for June 21 from 9am to 10pm
- **Make Music Seattle** is a grand collaboration of musicians, music professionals, business owners, community centers, event producers and more. Everyone, yes, everyone is invited! New and innovative programming concepts are encouraged. This is music on an extremely broad scale created by people with open minds and big hearts with a common goal to bring communities together through a very simple thing: Listening and creating art together. Music is for everyone, not just the perfect pitched elite.
- Make Music Seattle will have an impact as simple as an over-the-back-fence chat, but as deep as the Big Bertha tunnel. When communities come together and share the experience of live performance, resentments and misunderstandings melt. They, after all, have created something together! Individuals of all ages and ethnicities will be musically engaged; doors will be opened to new experiences and ideas. When one person is inspired and educated, it enriches the culture of the whole community.
- This one-day event has had such world-wide success, we are confident that Seattle's first year will enjoy the same acclaim. It has the capacity to unravel the polarized knot of Seattle's music community; from the Seattle Symphony to Pike Place buskers, from Café Racer to the Paramount Theatre, from hip-hop to Bach and from aspiring musicians to seasoned professionals. Make Music Seattle is a never-been-built-before stage that's open and welcome to everyone.
