

PERFORMERS

INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTERING

RETURNING USER: Click “Log In”

NEW USER: Click “Register”

Fill out your basic contact information, acknowledge the terms & conditions, choose a password and click “Sign me up!”. After you register, you’ll be asked if you want to create a profile for a “Venue”, a “Performer”, or “Both”.

Choose “Performer” and fill out your information to build your profile. Now your account is created!

TIP: If you would like to accept performance requests, make sure the slider on the Availability page is set to “Accepting requests for performances”.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FINDING A VENUE MATCH

Once your performer profile is created, you can search for available venues by selecting “Find a Match” in the navigation bar of your dashboard.

When you have found a venue that is looking a performer of your genre, and is available during the time you are seeking, you may send them a request by clicking the “Request Performance” button.

Input the performance details, enter a message if desired and then click the “Request Performance” button.

FAQ

Do I need a busking license or permit?

Nope! As long as you perform at a Make Music Worcester approved venue between the hours of 10:00AM – 8:00PM you are covered!

Who can perform?

When we say, *Performed by Anyone, Enjoyed by Everyone*, we really mean it. All musicians are welcome, regardless of age or skill level.

What will Make Music Worcester do to help promote my concert?

All confirmed performances will be listed our website, in the Make Music Day App, and in our promotion of the festival. We encourage you to promote your event and interact with us on social media.

Will musicians be paid to perform?

We do not offer stipends for matched performances. The goal of the festival is to create a day of free, accessible music making.

I’m a musician, and I just realized I can’t play a show I requested.

If you are confirmed for multiple overlapping performances, or you realize you can’t perform for whatever reason, please take care to modify your request as soon as possible as a courtesy to the venue. Note, if you delete a profile, the system will alert anyone else who is matched to that profile.

VENUES

INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTERING

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Choose “Venue” and fill out your venue’s information to build your profile. Please fill be as detailed as possible. The more detail you provide, the better your potential matches and overall listing will be.

TIP: If you would like to accept performance requests, make sure the slider on the Availability page is set to “Allow requests from artists”

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FINDING A PERFORMER MATCH

Once your venue profile is created, you can search for available artists by selecting “Find a Match” in the navigation bar of your dashboard.

When you have found an artist that matches your venue details you may send them a request by clicking the “Request Performance” button.

Input the performance details, enter a message if desired and then click the “Request Performance” button.

What will Make Music Worcester do to help promote my concert?

Will I be compensated for hosting performances?

We do not offer stipends for matched performances. The goal of the festival is to create a day of free, accessible music making.

Do I need to provide power/equipment?

Electricity and equipment are not required but can be provided at your discretion.

Can I serve alcohol?

Venues with a valid liquor license can serve alcohol.

EVENT ORGANIZERS

If you already have a performer and venue lined up together, first register the venue, then click the “Input Artist Info” button on your dashboard. Enter the performance details and click the “Schedule Performance” button
